DO'S AND DON'TS

Basic Rules for safe, responsible, and approved behavior inside Corrections and Jail facilities



DO

- 1. Respect ALL authority. Immediately obey instructions from Prison Staff and INMATE ENCOUNTER Coordinator.
- 2. Be familiar with INMATE ENCOUNTER materials and Schedule.
- 3. Tell your INMATE ENCOUNTER Coordinator if you have medication or health issues that need special attention.
- 4. Wear casual clothing. No shorts, tank tops, open toed shoes, or inappropriate attire.
- 5. Relax, mingle with inmates, be yourself. Never argue. Listen twice as much as you talk.
- 6. Eat with inmates when this is possible.
- 7. Focus on presenting the "What do You Think?"
 - Evangelism tract.

Your INMATE ENCOUNTER Coordinator will advise you on any other restrictions at your unit.

DON'T

- Bring cameras, tape recorders, cellular phones, iPods, or any electronic devices.
- Bring ANY unnecessary items such as extra clothing, billfolds, purses, knives, tools, etc.
- 3. RUN in or outside the facility.
- 4. Go into restricted areas or leave without approval from your INMATE ENCOUNTER Coordinator.
- Ask inmates about their crimes, and absolutely do not discuss the death penalty.
- 6. ARGUE with anyone; criticize any "religion" or "lifestyle."
- Pass out anything except the approved materials your Coordinator has given you.
- 8. TALK during Programs.
- 9. Make promises you will not keep.
- 10. Give out your personal address or phone number.
- 11. Take Bibles larger than pocket size.

Your INMATE ENCOUNTER Coordinator will brief you on other prison concerns; tobacco, hats, jewelry, cash, etc.

Our PURPOSE and FOCUS during this INMATE ENCOUNTER is BASIC EVANGELISM.

We all agree, a person must be "Born Again." Keep it simple and in the middle of the road.
